#### **Tinto 2021**

In 2021, as a result of the ongoing work of studying our soils aided by consultant Pedro Parra, we selected the best 500L barrel from the best vineyard in each of our 3 soil types - sand, limestone and granite - while keeping as many of the other variables constant. This is a 100% single vineyard Syrah from our coastal vineyard near Vila Nova de Milfontes.

Kaleidioscope of cool climate syrah aromatics revolve around cedarwood, nutmeg and white pepercorns intertwined by an intense floral lift of lavender and violets.

Fresh and elegant with a delicate grainy tannin that grounds however slightly the ethereal lifted expression of this aerian wine.

Variety: 100% Syrah

Soil: Sandy gravels of vulcanic origin

Site: Vila Nova de Milfontes, 3km from the Atlantic ocean

Vinification: Handpicked, spontaneous fermentation with 33% whole cluster, 21 days of

maceration with gentle extraction

Aging: 24 months in used 500L french oak puncheons

Alcohol: 12,5%
Total SO2 62mg/L
Bottled at the family estate in October 2023
600 bottles of 75cl produced

### **Granito**

#### **Tinto 2021**

In 2021, as a result of the ongoing work of studying our soils aided by consultant Pedro Parra, we selected the best 500L barrel from the best vineyard in each of our 3 soil types - sand, limestone and granite - while keeping as many of the other variables constant.

This is a 100% single vineyard Syrah from a east facing hilside behind our winery in Vidigueira.

Soaring aromatics of red cherry and blackberry, laced with violets, graphite and black pepper. The granularity of the tannins reveal the granitic soil where it's grown. A seamless and lingering combination of purity, elegance and power.

Soil: Decomposed clay, silty stony quartzic granite

Site: Cortes de Cima, Vidigueira

Vinification: Handpicked during the cool of night, spontaneous fermentation with 33% whole

cluster, 20 days of maceration with gentle extraction. Aging: 24 months in used 500L french oak puncheons

Alcohol: 12,5% Total SO2 64 mg/L Bottled at the family estate in October 2023 650 bottles of 75cl produced

# Calcário

### **Tinto 2021**

In 2021, as a result of the ongoing work of studying our soils aided by consultant Pedro Parra, we selected the best 500L barrel from the best vineyard in each of our 3 soil types - sand, limestone and granite - while keeping as many of the other variables constant. This is a 100% single vineyard Syrah from a east facing slope behind our winery in Vidigueira.

Vibrant aromas of red cherry, redcurrant with herbal undertones. Very pure and focused. The red fruits follow through on the palate with fine grained chalky tannins highlighting the clarity of the limestone soils, balanced with a crunchy acidity.

Variety: 100% Syrah

Soil: Decomposed clay over very fractured silty, sandy limestone

Site: Cortes de Cima, Vidigueira

Vinification: Handpicked during the cool of night, spontaneous fermentation with 66% whole

cluster, 16 days of maceration with gentle extraction Aging: 24 months in used 500L french oak puncheons

Alcohol: 13% Total SO2 52 mg/L Bottled at the family estate in October 2023 500 bottles of 75cl produced
